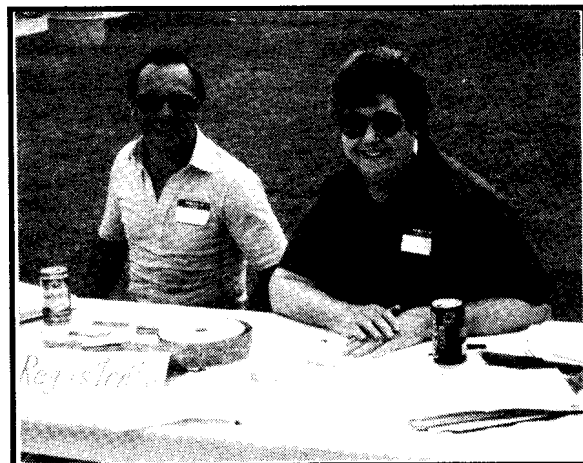
DID YOU KNOW.....

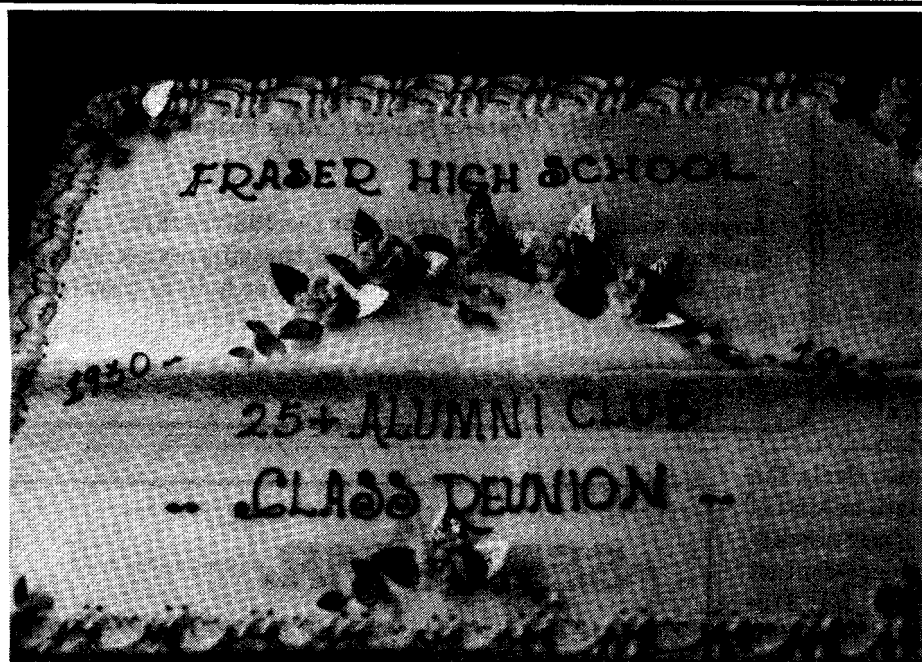

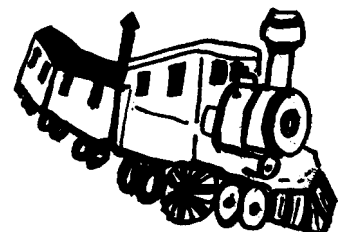
