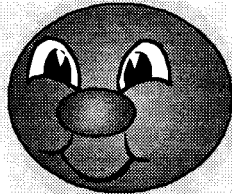

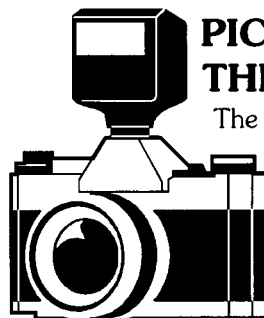
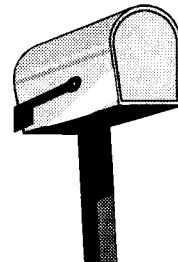

Elephant Ears

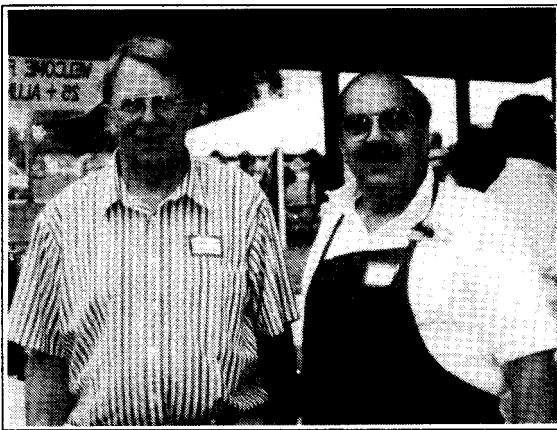

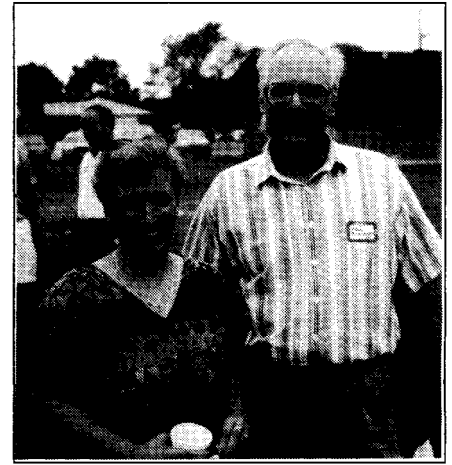

Shirley Schutt Alward, Class of '56 and her family opened a new grocery store in Bruce Township north of Romeo. Congratulations to the entire family.

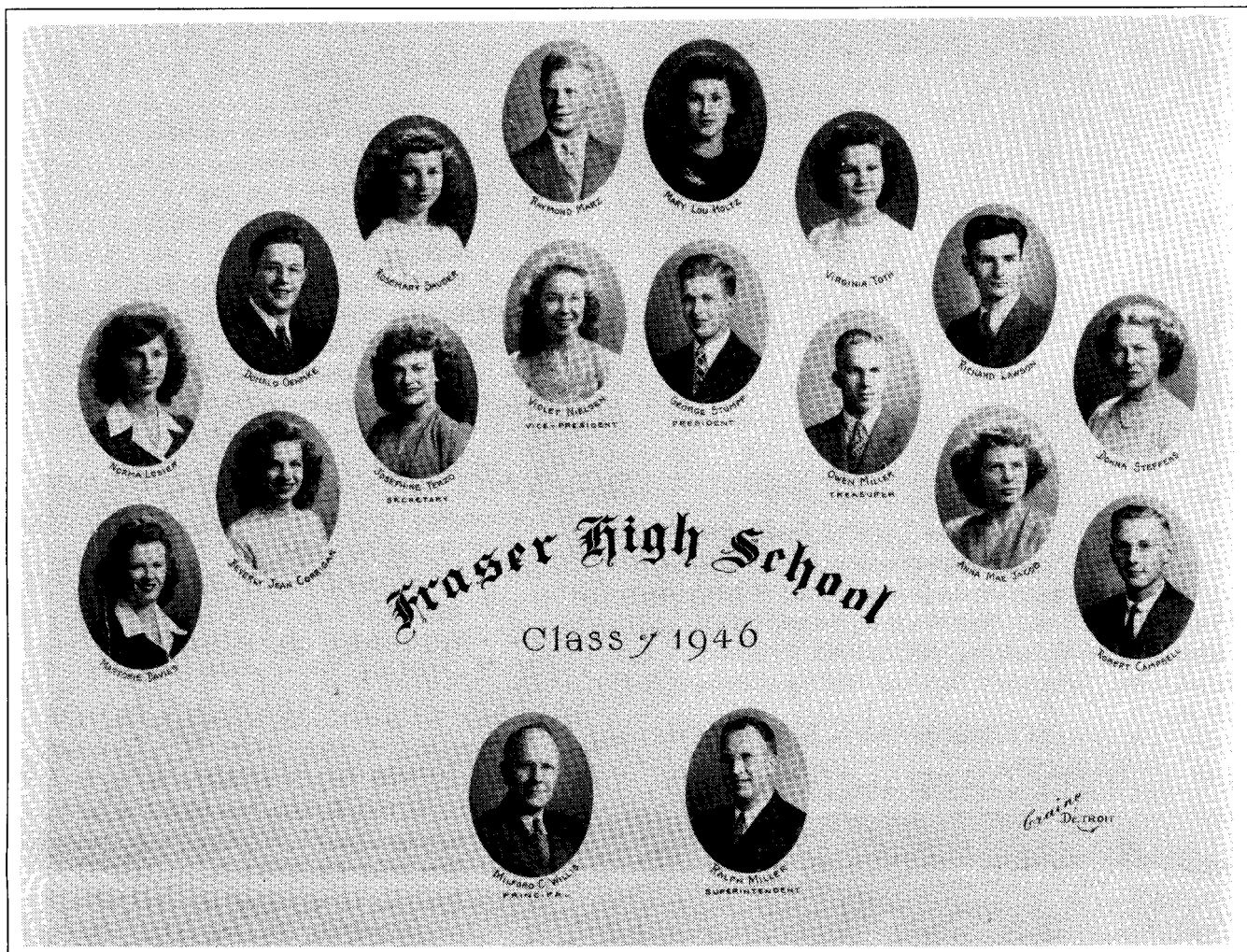

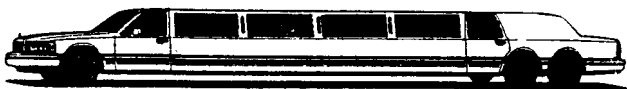

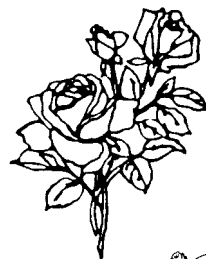
