#### JOHN PORTER '77

Many years ago, John attended a FHS Alumni Picnic and offered to roast a pig free of charge to support the club's main goal...to raise money for scholarships to high school seniors of alumni parents. He said, "I'm always grateful for the education I have received at Fraser High School and will continue to roast the pigs as long as I can to support the program."

Just a glimpse at what takes place before the delicious pork roast sandwiches are ready for consumption at the picnic...John arrives about 6:30 p.m. the night before the annual FHS Alumni Picnic with his portable smoker trailing behind his pick up truck. He loads the charcoal and wood into the smoker. The pierced pig has been studded with garlic cloves and is draped in foil. The fire in the smoker is started around 8 p.m. The pig will smoke all night and should be done about 11 a.m. the next morning just before the picnic begins.

All through the night, John rechecks

the foil, vents and charcoal and temperature every two hours (at least) and then decides whether more fuel is needed. He maintains a temperature of 300 degrees for the whole night.

Over the years, John has learned what it takes to keep the temperature up and even. During the night, he adjusts the opening and/or closing of the vents and determines whether or not to cover the smoker with blankets (not the wool ones) – the kind welders use that are made of fiberglass and rated to 1000 degrees Fahrenheit.

After graduation, John worked as a Toolmaker Apprentice at Lamb Technician, now known as MAG Powertrain. Throughout the years he held many positions and just recently has become the Sales Account Executive after being the Area Manager for the past 20 years. His work experience has taken him to many foreign countries. John says, "I've had a very successful career, thanks to all the Fraser High School teachers and faculty."

John has three children (their mom passed from breast cancer) and is currently married to Diane. He has a message for all women, "You must use flax seed daily!!" Some of his other interests included being a volunteer firefighter for many years in Goodland Township and roasting numerous pigs for Relay for Life, firefighter golf outings, etc.

When asked why he does this every year, John



replied "My family and I have had a good life and we want to give back."

So next time you attend a picnic, please take a few moments to thank John and his family for all of their time, effort, and money donated for such a wonderful cause. You know where to find him – yes, at the big, black smoker!

We are so thankful for them because it could not be possible with just the handful or two of committee members who are always attending the meetings and picnics year after year.


